
2022 Vulnerability Assessment: Butler County



Butler County ranked in the 5th quintile (111th out of 115 counties) for the opioid overdose vulnerability assessment and in the 5th quintile (110th) for the bloodborne infection vulnerability assessment. In the opioid overdose assessment, Butler County ranked in the 5th quintile for 9 out of 11 indicators with the rate of opioid-related Substance Use Disorder Treatment (SUDT) being its worst ranking at 113th. For the bloodborne infection assessment, it ranked in the 5th quintile for 12 out of 14 indicators with the rate of Injection Drug Use (IDU) among Substance Use Disorder Treatment (SUDT) recipients being its worst ranking at 112th. Social and economic factors were also included in these assessments, and the county's unemployment rate and poverty rate having the lowest rankings.
