
## 2022 Vulnerability Assessment: Dunklin County



Dunklin County ranked in the 5th quintile (103rd out of 115 counties) for the opioid overdose vulnerability assessment and in the 5th quintile (96th) for the bloodborne infection vulnerability assessment as well. In the opioid overdose assessment, Dunklin County's worst ranking was for the rate of poor mental health days. For the bloodborne infection assessment, its worst ranking was for the rate of drug-related arrests. Social and economic factors were also included in these assessments, and they had a large impact on Dunklin County's rank, with all of the factors ranking in the 5th quintile.
