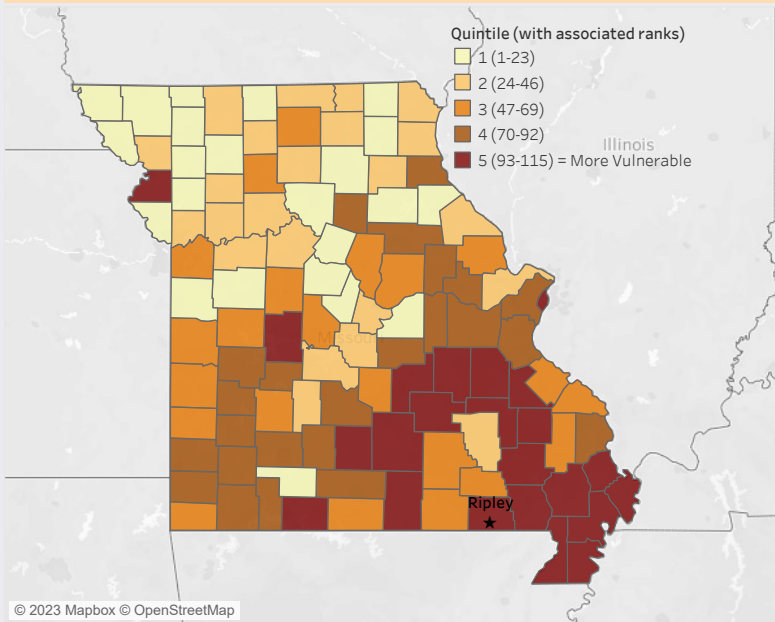
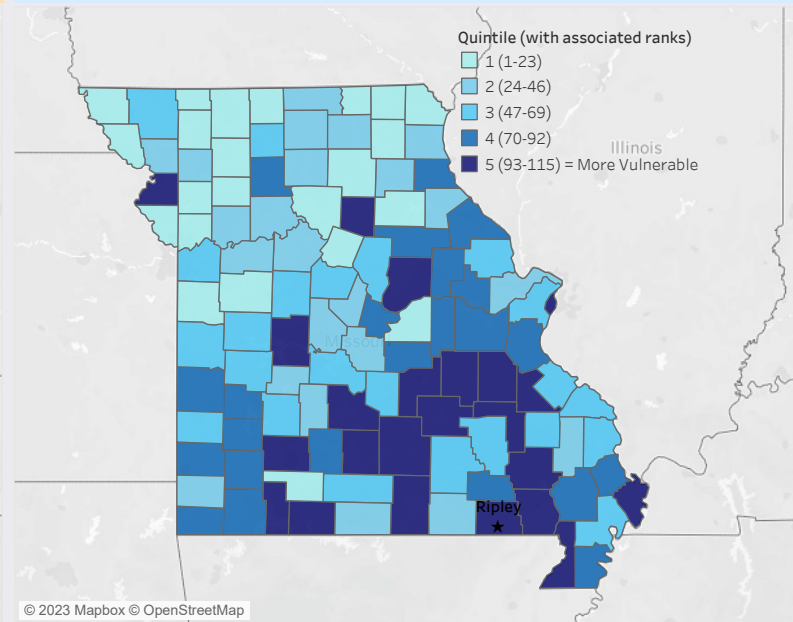

Ripley County ranked in the 5th quintile (101st out of 115 counties) for the opioid overdose vulnerability assessment and in the 5th quintile (95th) for the bloodborne infection vulnerability assessment. In the opioid overdose assessment, Ripley County's worst ranking was for the rate of poor mental health days at a rank of 113th. For the bloodborne infection assessment, its worst ranking was for the rate of opioid misuse ER visits ranking 93rd. Social and economic factors were also included in these assessments, and the county's rate of poverty was its worst ranking factor.
