Did You Know

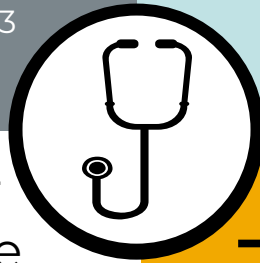
\$18.2 million

in hospital charges were for children with asthma.³

5,564 emergency

department visits were for asthma among children

11% of children under the age of 18 were diagnosed with asthma during their lifetime.¹



39% of asthma hospitalizations were for children.³

43% of children with asthma had an "asthma attack" in the past year.²

39% of children with asthma had to limit their activities due to asthma.²
