- II. Update from the State

Nicole Gamm gave the update from the state.

 - a. Nicole addressed the delay in receiving reports back from the state after a survey. She said they will be finished with the back log of surveys July 1st. She said she went back to look at what the delay has been. She said that the discrepancies have gone up from averaging about 15 a couple years ago to this year she has sited 99 discrepancies from Jan to Nov 2022. She said that between all of the TCD there has been 327 discrepancies written. She said they try to work through issues with the hospitals. She said that they are adding another FTE. She said there is only one attorney for TCD.
 - b. Nicole acknowledged the TCD managers. She said that one of the themes of issues has been administrative commitment. Staffing turn over has been an issue. PI has also been seen as an issue.
 - c. Nicole was asked if there will be a spreadsheet with list of regulations. Nicole said that will be the state's checklist. She said they are working on it and will share it.
