Florida, Texas, Arkansas are states that are using Pulsara. Helen reported the platform was presented to the East Central region. Mark Flauter asked how it would affect hospitals who already have a different product. It was recognized that if Pulsara, or any like product, were selected it would be gradually implemented as other contracts expired. Dr. Andrews asked John and Kari Barclay to review their experiences with Pulsara at their recent MO HOPE disaster exercise. The exercise included the University and the NW Region. There were 304 simulated patients. 7 of those patients were transferred to other hospitals in the area. The exercise was good practice. Kari said MHA has been exploring systems that would meet the criteria of daily use and also during disasters on a statewide system. She will ask
