Policies and Procedures for:
Sheltering in place for patients and staff
Safe evacuation from the inpatient facility to include:
Consideration of care and treatment needs of patients
Staff responsibilities
o Transportation
Identification of evacuation location(s)
<ul> <li>Primary and alternate means of communication with external sources of assistance</li> </ul>
<ul> <li>System for tracking the location of hospice staff and sheltered patients or staff and patients relocated</li> </ul>
<ul> <li>Provision of subsistence needs –</li> </ul>
Food, water, medical, and pharmaceutical supplies
Alternate sources of energy to maintain temperatures and safe storage of provisions
Emergency lighting
Fire detection, extinguishing, and alarm systems
Sewage and waste disposal
<ul> <li>Role of hospice in providing care at alternate sites during emergencies</li> </ul>
<ul> <li>Communication plan includes a means of providing information about the facility's needs, and its ability to provide assistance, to the authority having jurisdiction during an emergency</li> </ul>
<ul> <li>Communication plan includes a means of providing information about the inpatient facility occupancy</li> </ul>
